



Adult Pickup Programs

Rules & Procedures

Registration

All participants are required to register for a pickup program previously on the Recreation website. No one is allowed to play without registering and paying. The program is not drop-in or free.

Sign-In

All participants are required to sign in each time they attend. A sign-in sheet will be available each night and this must be done before playing.

Program Participants

Only registered participants are allowed to attend and be in the facility. No siblings, children, spouses, partners, boy/girlfriends, or other spectators are allowed- Only Participants.

Program Supervisors

Program supervisors are responsible for facilitating pick-up games and ensuring that all participants sign in. Program supervisors are also responsible for maintaining a safe, fair, and welcoming environment for all.

Program Times

Programs begin promptly at the designated time. The facility will not open or be available before the start time. Participants may arrive 5 minutes before the start time, no earlier. There is **NO** hanging out in hallways. Exterior doors will be locked at 7:15 pm. Participants must arrive before this time.

Tobacco, Drugs & Alcohol Free

There is **NOT** to be any tobacco, alcohol, or drug use, selling, or distributing before, during, or after the pickup programs. You must be drug and alcohol-free to participate in the pickup program, otherwise, you will be asked to leave and not to return to the program. Police will be contacted if there is any suspicion of Tobacco, Alcohol, or Drug use on the property.

Equipment

All equipment must remain in the R.E.C. Zone. There is to be no use of equipment outside the facility.

Wet Shoes or Boots

For the safety of all participants. Participants must change into dry shoes before entering the playing area. Keep all wet clothing and shoes stored on/near the coat racks & benches.

Respect Program Supervisors, Participants & Other Staff

All participants are expected to treat each other with respect. Program Supervisors will be listened to and always respected. Failure to do so will result in being asked to leave and not to return to the program. Police will be contacted if needed.

Clean Up

At the end of the night, be sure the area is picked up and all personal belongings are accounted for.

Cancellations

If the building is closed, due to weather or any issue that prevents the use of the space, there will be no pickup programs. Participants will be contacted via email.

Suspension of Program

Not following or being disrespectful of these rules & procedures will result in suspension or termination from the program.
