VILLAGE COMMUNITY PARK

- This park offers separate playgrounds for children 5-12 years and 2-4 years, 4 sand volleyball courts, a soccer field, a little league field, space for multipurpose fields, picnic tables, charcoal grills, a lighted area for skate park elements, basketball court, and an ice-skating rink in the winter. There is also a 9-hole disc golf course, with a warm-up area of three baskets.
